

#### SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY 2025-26

The use of school uniforms has several significant benefits. Uniforms allow students to look like students, develop school spirit, and promote an understanding of school being a special place with special expectations. It also allows students to be seen by others on the basis of their unique personalities and not on the basis of their clothing. All uniform items must be school colors but can be purchased from multiple suppliers (unless otherwise noted).

SCHOOL COLORS (Solid): Navy, Maroon/Burgundy, Gray (multiple shades), White

## YOUNG MEN, K-12th Grade

- Pants/Shorts
  - Plain navy/gray slacks with appropriate fit (not baggy or tight fitted).
  - Navy/Gray shorts may be worn. Shorts must be no shorter than the middle of the thigh.
- Tops
  - White oxfords or solid uniform-colored polos (long or short sleeves) with collars.
  - Blazers may be worn in navy/gray
  - Sweaters (button, pullover or vests) in solid school colors may be worn with uniform-colored collared shirt underneath.
  - Crewneck sweatshirts in solid school colors may be worn with uniform-colored collared shirts underneath
  - Land's End ties (using school codes, see website for options).
- Enclosed heel and toe shoes (no light-up shoes or shoes with wheels)

# YOUNG LADIES, K-12th Grade

- Pants/Shorts/Skirts/Dresses
  - Plain navy/gray slacks with appropriate fit (not baggy or tight fitted).
  - Navy/Gray shorts may be worn. Shorts must reach the middle of the thigh or longer.

- **K-6th**: For patterned skirts/dresses/jumpers please see Land's End and/or French Toast (using school codes, see websites for options). Solid Dresses and skirts must be uniform-color and similar in style to the Lands End school page.
- 7th 12th: Skirts must be uniform-colored. Dresses may be uniform-color and style of your choice. Dresses must have modest necklines with no visible cleavage. No sleeveless dresses permitted.
- Skirts/dresses/jumpers must not be shorter than 2 inches above the knees.
- Solid colored shorts, tights, or leggings must be worn under skirts, dresses, jumpers.

## Tops

- White oxfords or solid uniform-colored polos (long or short sleeve) with collars.
- Blazers may be worn in solid school colors
- Sweaters (button, pullover, vests, or cardigans) in solid school colors may be worn with a uniform-colored collared shirt underneath.
- Crewneck sweatshirts in solid school colors may be worn with a uniform-colored collared shirt underneath.
- Enclosed heel and toe shoes (no light-up shoes or shoes with wheels)

#### PERSONAL APPEARANCE

- Hair standards:
  - Boys: hair is to be neat and clean. It must not cover the collar, hang in the student's face or cover the sides of his ears. Unusual hair coloration or styling (ie. mohawks, buns) is unacceptable.
  - No facial hair for boys.
  - **Girls**: hair must be neat and clean and must not be over the eyes. Unusual hair coloration or styling is unacceptable.
- Hats/caps are not to be worn in building unless authorized by the Administration.
- Ladies may wear scarves and hair accessories that coordinate with uniform.
- Other issues related to cleanliness or neatness of the uniform, hairstyles or color, or general appearance of students, although not specifically addressed in the school dress code can be judged appropriate or inappropriate by the Administration. If it is determined that a student's appearance is a distraction, the student will be expected to make recommended modifications.

#### CLARIFICATIONS/MISC

- Only uniform-colored coats/jackets may be worn in the building.
- No electronic devices such as smart watches, smart glasses, or fitness devices (anything with a black screen) are allowed to be worn on campus.
- No visible undergarments.
- How will you know if clothing is too tight?

- Shirts should have some loose fabric on them when worn and not be pulled tight against the body or be pulling at the buttons.
- Pants should not be pulled tight against the body and should be slightly relaxed. Jeggings/Leggings are not allowed.
